From until his death Ferdinand therefore devoted most of his attention to Europe. Though always sustained by its Catholic mission, the Spanish Empire came together initially by accident, not by design. Spanish aid was supplied to the colonies via four main routes: 1 from French ports with the funding of Roderigue Hortalez and Company ; 2 through the port of New Orleans and up the Mississippi river; 3 from warehouses in Havana; and 4 from the northwestern Spanish port of Bilbao, through the Gardoqui family trading company which supplied significant war materiel.
